



YUCONIA (No. 4)

GEOGRAPHY

This land consists mostly of plains with scattered forests of no little size. There are also many small streams just large enough to be navigable by flat-bottomed barges, and a great many fresh water lakes known for their beauty and stock of fish. Wolves, rabbits, bears, and many mammals inhabit this land. Vorgs also roam the wild and prey on unwary travelers and merchants.

It is a cold and damp place with a short growing season. There isn't as much snowfall in this land as there is in the other northern countries because circular wind currents keep most storms out at sea.



The forests are mostly new growth as the inhabitants are constantly cutting them down, though only for local use, so they have a chance to grow again. Some wheat and vegetables are grown here, but usually only on a subsistence basis, and most food is imported.

PEOPLE

RACES

This land is very tolerant in regards to race, and many different peoples can be found here. Humans are the largest part of the population followed closely by gnomes, dwarves, and elves, in that order. The people are practical and there is little serious racism.

PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The inhabitants of this land are fairly new arrivals, as few chose to live in Yuconia before trade routes were opened with the east, as there are few natural resources and the climate is inhospitable. Thus the inhabitants' physical appearance is that of people of the land from whence they came. Long-term residents often mix together and show some shared physical characteristics.
